- Cut off the bottom of a clear plastic bottle. Stuff the neck of the bottle with clean cotton wool.
- Turn the bottle upside down and place it on a clean glass.
- Over the cotton wool, spread a layer of small pebbles, then gravel and above that a layer of sand. All pebbles, gravel and sand must be washed before putting in the bottle.
- Pour dirty water over these layers of filter.

Watch the water drops trickling down through the cotton wool. This way dirty water is being filtered and all the insoluble impurities are removed from the water.
