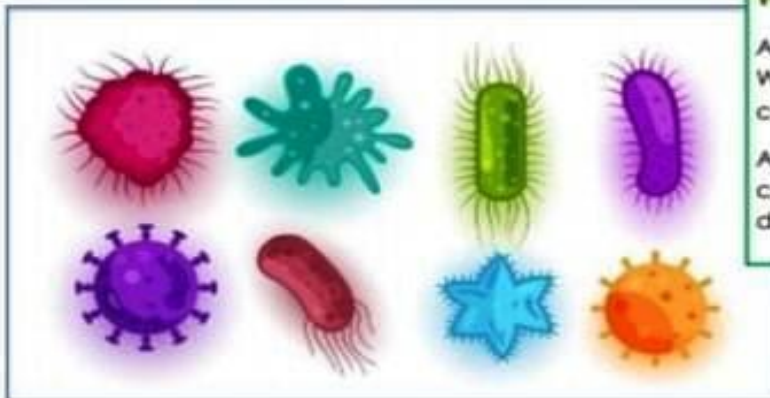

What is a virus?

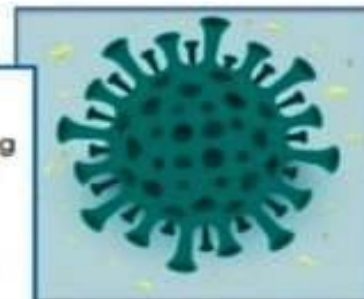
A virus is a type of germ. It can make us sick. When you have a fever, a runny nose and a cough, it's a germ that is making you sick.

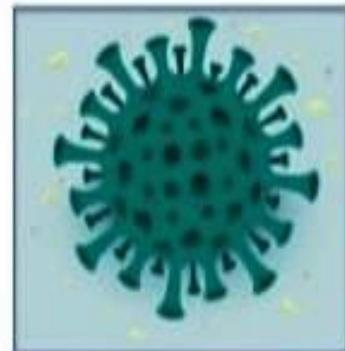
