For hundreds of years, scientists and plant lovers have preserved dried plants for study in herbariums to use the dataassociated with it for scientific study. Instructions: • Collect ten leaves of different plants. • Clean off any dirt or bugs from the plant. • Dry all the leaves by placing them in between the pages. • You can dry all the leaves in the same book by spacing them several pages apart. • Set it aside for 8-10 days to let the leaves dry. • Once the leaves are dry, you are ready to compile your herbarium pages. • Using narrow pieces of tape, secure each leaf on an A4 size pastel sheet.

# **Computers**


